## **Rider, Member, and Dues Policies**

## Riders

- Those applying for Rider membership will not be accepted until the Ride Captain makes an appointment for the applicant to demonstrate their ability to: control their horse; and ride 2-5 miles at apace necessary to meet Re-Ride requirements.
- 2. Must be at least 14 years of age, with parent or guardian approval.
- **3.** Ride selection is done by seniority established by date of qualification.
- **4.** Riders must be at the Re-Ride sign-up to pick a ride, or if the rider cannot attend due to extenuating circumstances acceptable to the Board, must call a Board Member prior to the meeting or prior to the Re-Ride to discuss ride selection.
- 5. Riders need to be involved in the Re-Ride at least once every two years to maintain seniority. Involvement may be riding a selected ride, or acting in a support capacity such as Ride Lieutenant, being part of support for a particular rider, assisting a ride lieutenant, being a Ham operator, being at a ride site to help there, or helping with the Brockliss crossing.
- **6.** If a Rider is not involved for two years, they go to the bottom of the seniority list and need to regain seniority from that new place on the list.
- Rider must be at designated location <u>on time to be ready for the mochila exchange when</u> <u>the incoming rider gets there</u>. From Nevada-California border to Bullion Bend <u>on time</u> is 2 hours before scheduled ride time. From Bullion Bend to Discovery Park <u>on time</u> is one hour before scheduled ride time.
- 8. Renewal membership can be denied for any Rider who selects a ride, does not show up for that ride, and did not show good cause to the Ride Captain <u>prior</u> to the ride. Membership may be renewed the following year with previous seniority lost.

## Member

- **1.** Categories of membership:
  - a. Rider Has qualified to ride in the annual National Re-Ride.
  - b. Associate Dues paying member. Can do everything a rider does except: vote, hold office, sit on mochila on re-ride.
  - c. Honorary National Member- No dues. California Division pays for ride letter.
  - d. CA Honorary Full member (Rider)-Dues \$15.00--\$10.00 to National and \$5.00 for letter.
  - e. Honorary Recognized by CA as a special person; no dues.
  - f. Lifetime member Paid one-time \$400 National dues. Does not cover California dues and letter.
